1. North Zealand – Tour approx. 5 hours



As we leave Copenhagen and head North, for almost a whole hour, the coastline of Sweden follows us. We drive through the magnificent Danish countryside and coastline all the way up to Elsinore and Kronborg Castle.

Kronborg Castle in Elsinore, at the seaward approach to The Sound  resund, is one of northern Europe's most important Renaissance castles. Known all over the world from Shakespeare's Hamlet, it is also the most famous castle in Denmark and is visited each year by about 200,000 Danes and tourists.



Frederik II's Kronborg is both an elegant Renaissance castle and a monumental military fortress surrounded by major fortifications with bastions and ravelins. Some of the historical rooms house collections of Renaissance and Baroque interiors, and among the most important attractions are the 62-metre long ballroom, the wonderfully preserved chapel and the statue of "Holger the Dane".

Afterwards we head back to Copenhagen and along the way stop for refreshments hosted by Jakob Demant at his home in Rungsted Kyst".

2. The Christiania Tour approx. 3 hours



The tour starts by coach from Copenhagen to Christiania, also known as Freetown Christiania (Danish: Fristaden Christiania) is a partially self-governing neighbourhood of about 850 residents, covering 34 hectares (85 acres) in the borough of Christianshavn in the Danish capital Copenhagen. Christiania has established semi-legal status as an independent community, but has been a source of controversy since its creation in a squatted military area in 1971. Its open cannabis trade was tolerated by authorities until 2004. Since then, measures for normalising the legal status of the community have led to conflicts, and negotiations are ongoing. Among many Christiania residents, the community is known as staden ('the town'), short for fristaden ('the freetown').

After a guided tour the tour ends at Christiania.

3. The Brewery Tour – approx. 3 hr.

The tour starts by coach from Copenhagen to the Carlsberg Brewery. Carlsberg is one of the Nordic region's oldest breweries and reveals at the same time an impressive and compelling story about the founder J.C. Jacobsen and his son Carl. The 10.000 m² Visitors Centre is located within the buildings of J.C. Jacobsen's original brewery founded in 1847.

Several of the remarkable production halls have been converted into exhibition areas and tableaux presenting highlights from Carlsberg's fascinating historical development.
